

BEST PRACTICES

1. The college is introducing SELF-FINANCED skill development programme for the students and the community through self-sustaining resources by the Teaching and Non-Teaching staff has positively impacted them since the start-up programme in 2019. Small scale farming by the students has been encouraged through-out sourcing of the produced to the College Hostels and the community market shed.
2. Introduction of a hearse vehicle in collaboration with the Red Cross Society has encouraged a feeling of oneness amongst the institutions fraternity and the community. It is the only institution to manage a private hearse in the capital city catering to the economically weaker section and for distant villages residing in the capital. The prices/charges are below the rates of the Red Cross Society which has deeply impressed the humanitarian act of the institution.
